Ferals - Colonies are fed & watered daily. Volunteers are asked to pick one day a week or month that they can do this. Could include several colonies. Food can be provided if needed. We are also in need of people to help with TNR (trap, neuter, return). This could be trapping, transporting and/or recovering ferals before they are returned to existing colonies or new barn homes.

Adoptions - Assist with adoption events by setting up and tearing down, speaking with potential adopters and the general public about our organization and programs, and monitoring interactions between visitors and the cats.

Petco - clean and maintain cat cages while monitoring the cats health. The Petco cats require care twice daily (morning and afternoon/evening), and this schedule is shared among several volunteers to ensure coverage seven days a week. Volunteers also interact with the public, answer questions about the cats, and share information about our organization. Strong customer service skills are helpful.

Events - working at booths when we participate in public events or possibly things we sponsor such as a garage sale. Includes setting up and tearing down.

Donation pickups - picking up donations and dropping off where needed. This could include items donated for garage sales or pet food donations.

Fundraising - assist in organizing and running fundraisers.

Transportation of cats - transporting cats safely to vet appointments, events, foster homes or other places as needed.
